The School will:

Behaviour

The School will:

Ensure that children learn the importance of behaving well and the impact their behaviour has on their education and futures.

To behave in a way that sets children a good example when I am on school premises.

Attendance & Punctuality

The School will:

Start lessons promptly at 8.45 a.m.

Maintain an accurate record of attendance.

Take action where attendance falls below 97%.

To contact the school promptly on the first day of absence.

Make every effort to take holidays in school breaks.
