

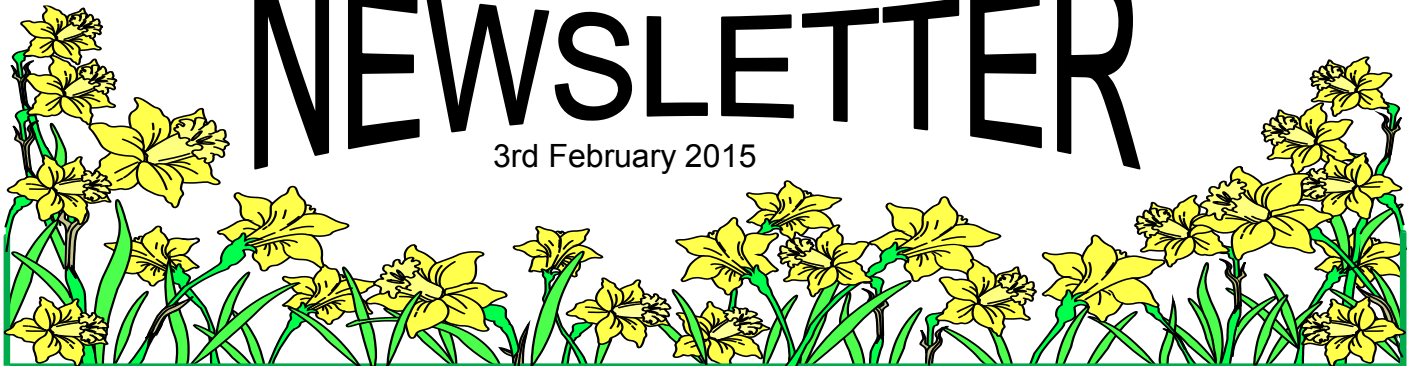

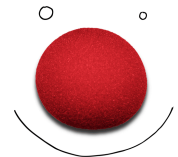
## WEAR IT RED DAY—FRIDAY 6TH FEBRUARY

## COLLECTING CHILDREN FROM SCHOOL
