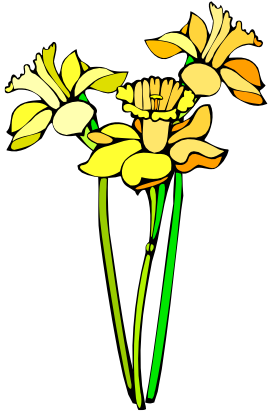

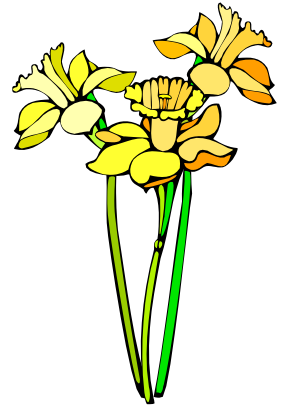

PARKING

Please, please, please park safely and considerately when bringing your child/children to school or collecting them at the end of the day. We continue to receive reports from the police, parents and residents of dangerous and thoughtless driving of a very small minority, which is endangering the safety of everyone. If you do see any incidents of dangerous driving/parking, please report car registrations to the police.

We would also like to remind you that the School Crossing Patrol Warden is there to ensure the safety of your children whilst they are crossing the road outside school and that abusive language and unacceptable behaviour towards them will not be tolerated.

QUESTIONS, QUERIES AND CONCERNS

If you have a concern please make an appointment with your child's class teacher in the first instance, through the office. Alternatively you can speak to class teachers at the end of the day, once the class has been dismissed. Any urgent messages with need to be passed on during the day or at the beginning of the day, can either be given to the staff on duty on the front playground or by calling the office.
