DINNER MONEY

BREAKFAST CLUB

The Junior School runs a Breakfast Club which is available to all children from Reception to Yr 6. The early session has limited availability, starts at 7.45am and must be booked in advance. Booking forms are available from the Junior School office. The cost is £4.00 for the first child per session, siblings are £3.00 per child per session. This charge does not include the cost of any breakfast items and children need to bring money with them each day, if they wish to have their breakfast in school. Children attending this session should not arrive in school before 7.45 as there are no staff in school before that time to supervise them.

The later session starts at 8.25am and is free of charge, but children must purchase a breakfast each day they attend. Children arriving early for this session will not be admitted before 8.25am.

UNIFORM
