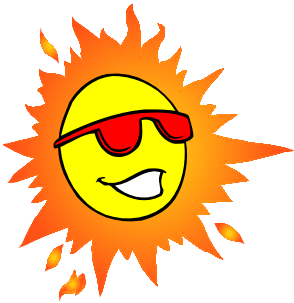

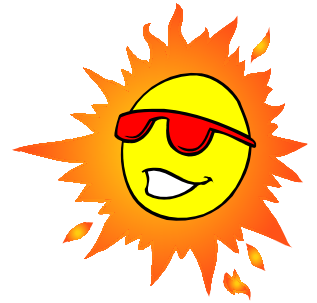

I am writing to let you know about some changes to the constitution of the Governing Body. These statutory changes apply to all schools in England and must be implemented to comply with new Government Regulations by 1st September 2015.

With effect from the 2nd March 2015 the Governing Body was reconstituted and now is made up of the following structure: 2 Parent Governors, 1 Staff Governor, 1 Headteacher, 1 Local Authority Governor and 3 Co-opted Governors.

I would like to thank Eddie Currall, Anne Lowe, Kerry Westwood and Kelly Jack for their support and the contribution they made to school as governors on the former Governing Body.

I would also like to welcome Colin Simmonds, Mapiye Hwekwete and Gurmeet Sian as they join the Governing Body as Co-opted governors.

We also need additional Relief Lunchtime Supervisors, who live locally and are willing to work, sometimes at short notice to cover staff absence.

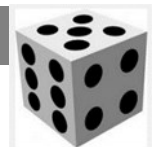
