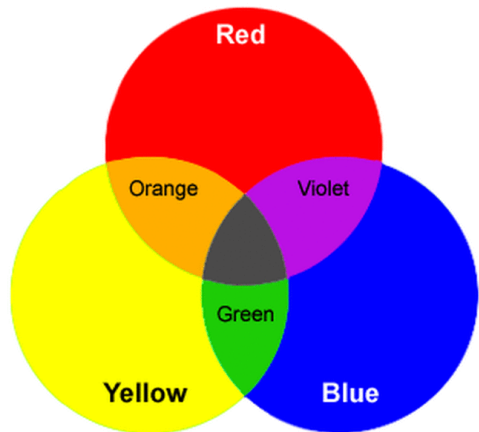


Key Terms: Topic Fact Sheet – Block 2 (Drawing and Painting)

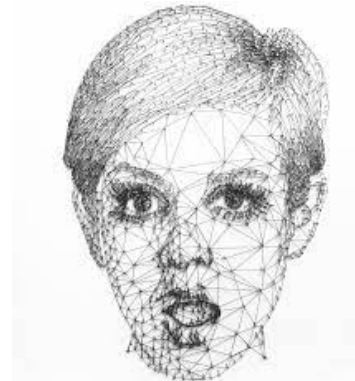
Line	A mark, which can vary in length, width, direction and shape, made on a surface that joins different points. These can be used for many different reasons – physical appearance or movement, emotion and atmosphere.
Tone	How light or dark something is, A way to add light and shadow to your drawing and make images look 3-D.
Primary colour	Red, blue and yellow, which can be mixed together to produce other colours.
Secondary colour	Secondary colours are made by mixing two primary colours.
Composition	The arrangement of different elements within an artwork or design.



Examples of careers which use colour theory: interior designer, video game designers, graphic designers, fashion designers, photographers bakers, art teachers and florists.

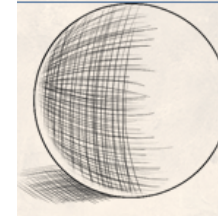


Ancient Egyptian Art refers to art first used in 3000 B.C. Much of the artwork created by the Ancient Egyptians had to do with their religion.

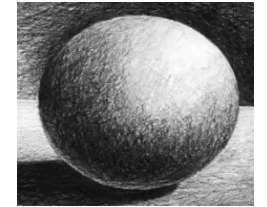


Imogen Morris is a Birmingham based artist who creates portraits using nails and thread.

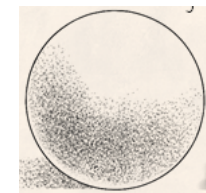
Shading techniques:
