Grammar

When we say and write colours as adjectives after the noun in French the spelling changes to match the noun and whether it is singular or plural and masculine or feminine.

e.g. le tshirt **blanc**/ les tshirts **blancs**
la jupe **blanche**/les jupes **blanches**
