#### Curriculum

The School will:

Provide a broad, balanced, engaging and exciting curriculum to help every child become a successful and lifelong learner.

Provide a stimulating learning environment to enable children to learn and to make good progress.



#### Tintend:

To work in partnership with school to ensure that my child is making the most of the opportunities offered.

To support my child's learning at school by attending parents meetings, workshops, assemblies and performances.

To ensure that my child brings the correct equipment to school each day e.g. PE Kit, reading book, planner and homework.

## Behaviour
