Religions that we are learning from:

Christianity

In the New Testament Jesus often treated people fairly regardless of their ethnicity, gender or status.

<u>Islam</u>

Muslims believe that it is important to be fair and just with others as directed in the Quran.

<u>The Bible – John 4 v 1-42</u>

This story is about how Jesus interacted with a Samaritan woman at the well. Jesus was a Jew and Jews typically hated Samaritans. However the story shows that Jesus treated the woman with compassion and respect.

Key questions to discuss at home:

- What does it mean to treat people fairly?
- Should everyone always be treated the same?
- How can you treat people fairly?
- What should you do if you see someone being treated unfairly?

Key Vocabulary:

Fair – treating people equally

Unfair – treating people unequally

Discriminate - treating people differently (often unfairly)

Prejudice – having an opinion that is not based on good reason or experience
