HOMEWORK

Reading – your child will have two reading books and a Bug Club login, please read with your child at home at least 3 times per week (more if possible).

Spellings – the children will have a spelling list to learn each week and a weekly test.

Times Tables – the children practice their tables at home using Times Tables Rock Stars, the teacher will set the practice to the correct level for your child.

Maths – if the teacher notices your child needs more practice with an objective they have taught, they may send homework to address this. This could be a worksheet or it could be a task set on Mathletics.

ATTENDANCE/REPORTING ABSENCES

Attendance is key to success. 90% attendance = four complete weeks lost, 85% attendance = six weeks lost which equals half a term, 80% attendance = more than half a term lost.

All unexplained absence is by law classified as unauthorised. All absences must have a valid necessary reason.

If your child is unwell and unable to come to school, please inform us by 9 am. Absence is monitored and you will be contacted if we have not received an explanation for your child's absence.

After 3 days of no contact we will conduct a home visit.

If you need to take your child out of school during the day for a medical appointment, please inform us in advance and provide medical evidence.

We strongly discourage parents from taking children out of school for holidays during school time. Parents are required to complete an 'Exceptional Circumstances-Leave in term time request form' These requests can only be authorised for exceptional circumstances. Any requests that are not authorised may result in legal action being taken.

LUNCHTIMES

If your child is not entitled to a free school meal you can order a dinner in the normal way. Unfortunately, we do not accept payment by cheque, and we will not be able to accept cash payments in the new academic year. All payments for dinner must be paid via our online banking facility. It is possible to have a mix of school lunches and sandwiches within a week.

The cost of a meal is £2.50 per day. This can either be paid weekly or each half term.

Dinner money for this half term is £82.50 or £12.50 per week.

BREAK TIME SNACKS

At break times the children can purchase a drink and or a piece of fruit from the Tuck Shop/Canteen.

If your child wishes to purchase these items then please send them with cash in a purse or envelope with their name and class labelled clearly.

Children can bring snacks from home and need to be healthy and NUT free.

We have a NO KIWI and NO NUT policy in our school due to children with current allergies.

BREAKFAST CLUB

The sessions are from 7.45am and cost £4 per session for the first child, £3 for siblings

Booking forms can be downloaded from our school website or ask at the office.

Breakfast Club is free from 8.25am if children purchase a drink or snack.

Toast is provided to all children in their classrooms each morning, free of charge.
