Religions that we are learning from:

Christianity

Christians believe that God created everyone in His own image and therefore all human life is precious and valued.

Islam

Muslims use their time of prayer as a time to show unity and harmony. This can be seen in the practices that Muslims follow whilst preparing for prayer and whilst praying.

Baha'i

Baha'is believe in the unity of humanity; that we are all one people. They believe that this knowledge is available to everyone, but often remains an undiscovered secret.

- What brings followers of different faiths together?
- What events do you take part in that bring your community together?
- Can you think of any events you would like to take part in that would bring people together?

Key Vocabulary:

Unity –being joined as a whole

Harmony –being in agreement

Adhan - the call to prayer (Islam)

Wudu - ceremonial washing (Islam)

Rakah – positions or movements whilst praying (Islam)
