Religions that we are learning from:

Christianity

Christians follow Jesus' teaching which tells them to treat everyone as their neighbour by showing kindness, regardless of who they are.

<u>Sikhism</u>

Bhai Kanhaiya is an example to Sikhs of how live their lives – caring for others whether they are friends, neighbours or even enemies.

Baptism

People who have decided that they want to follow Jesus often decide to get baptised. Immersing themselves in water is a symbolic way of showing that their past lives of not following God are gone. When they emerge from the water their new life of following God begins.

Key questions to discuss at home:

- How can you show commitment to others?
- How do believers show commitment to their faith?
- How important is it to commit to traditions?

Key Vocabulary:

Commitment – being dedicated to doing something

Loyal – giving or showing a firm and constant support

Steadfast – keeping going with something

Baptism – the Christian activity of immersing someone in water to show their forgiveness of sins and relationship with God.
