Religions that we are learning from:

Christianity

Christians are encouraged to solve disputes in person and in private and only involve others if it can not be resolved. Believers are encouraged to forgive others as God has forgiven them.

Islam

Muslims use their time of prayer as a time to show unity and harmony. This can be seen in the practices that Muslims follow whilst preparing for prayer and whilst praying.

<u>Baha'i</u>

Baha'I's believe in the unity of humanity; that we are all one people. They believe that this knowledge is available to everyone, but often remains an undiscovered secret.

Key questions to discuss at home:

- How are you both different from and also the same as everyone else?
- Would it be good if everyone were the same?
- In what ways do people of faith try to sort out disputes?
- How do you deal with difference and conflict?

Key Vocabulary:

Unity -being joined as a whole

Harmony —being in agreement

Conflict – a serious disagreement or argument

Holy Communion – Christian worship in which bread and wine is shared and believers are encouraged to forgive
