 After appearing on the 1st series of sewing bee, Stuart Hillard turned his passion for sewing into a career.



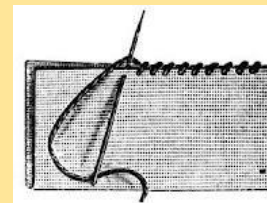
He has written books, designed fabrics, created blogs and videos and appeared on several shows and as a columnist in sewing magazines.



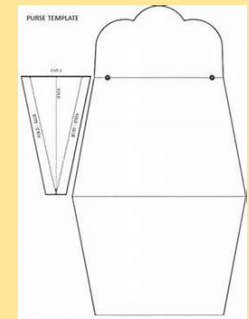

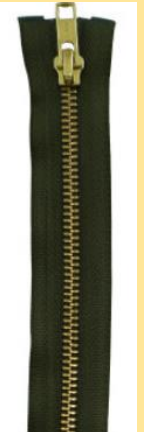
