Christianity

Christians believe that the Bible holds the truth about how to live according to God. Jesus taught that it is important to live honestly, always being prepared to tell the truth, even in difficult situations.

Key questions to discuss at home:

- Why does the truth matter?
- Have you ever been wrongly accused of something? How did it make you feel?
- How important do you feel it is to be honest?

Honesty

It can be easy to judge others and how often they are honest and not think about how honest we are. Many religious and non-religious groups place a big importance on telling the truth and being honest. This helps to develop trusting relationships in families and communities.

Key Vocabulary:

Truth – a fact or belief that is accepted as being right

False accusation – something that is said about another person that is not true

Honest – something that is right and true
