Religions that we are learning from:

Islam

Living with (or without) integrity becomes a 'way of life' a pattern. Muslims believe Allah (God) know the answers and sees everything. Muslims also believe that one day everyone will be judged by Allah. Allah (God) wants Muslims to think carefully before making any decisions or taking any action by asking themselves, 'Is what I am about to do just, will my actions hurt anyone?'

Christianity

Many believers think that God can see everything and knows everyone's motives. Some believers find it easier to own up to things they have done wrong, because they believe that God already knows what they have done, anyway.

Key questions to discuss at home:

- Can you let yourself down?
- Am I willing to be answerable to myself and others for my actions?
- Who do my actions affect?

Key Vocabulary:

Integrity – the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles

Accountable – required to explain actions to others

Motive – a reason for doing something
