Religions that we are learning from:

<u>Sikhism</u>

Today many Sikhs demonstrate their moral courage and commitment to the faith through partaking in the ceremony of Amrit. After this ceremony Sikhs can wear the 5 Ks. Not all Sikhs go through this ceremony.

Buddhism

Buddhism teaches the story of Angulimala and the Buddha. Buddha shows courage and bravery when faced with Angulimala's evil actions. Buddha's courage caused Angulimala to change his ways and become a monk.

- Where can we see people being confident, including in their faith?
- Where does courage come from?

Key Vocabulary:

Courage – the ability to do something even if it frightens you

Moral – if something is right or wrong or 'doing the right thing'

Ceremony – an occasion where an achievement or event is celebrated
